There are a limited number of rooms, so please make your reservations early. **The deadline for discounted room rates is December 30, 2022**. The 2021 Annual Conference sold out of rooms. Once these discounted rooms are sold out, no more discounts are available. NOTE: Rooms for Saturday, January 14th and Sunday, January 15th, are \$149 (plus tax) for those wanting to come in early. The regular rate is \$499 per night.
